Punj Lloyd gets solar contract

Funj Lioyo gets Solar contract Engineering and construction major Punj Lloyd today said in New Delhi it had won the country's largest solar-based contract worth Rs 232 crore for installing water treatment plants in Bihar from the state government. The EPC (engineering, procurement and construction) contract for 850 solar-powered water treatment plants for removal of arsenic and fluoride across multiple districts in Bihar will be implemented on a turnkey basis, a company statement said. "The combined solar power generation of these plants will be greater than 1.3 MW. With the government's com-mitment to the National Solar Mission, this project pro-vides the foundation to establish Punj Lloyd as a leading solar company in this space," it said. — PTI
