

Punj Lloyd bags deals worth ₹348 cr

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Punj Lloyd has won orders worth ₹139 crore from Adani Group and a ₹209-crore pipeline contract from the Mumbai Port Trust.

“The company has received Letters of Award from Adani for design, engineering, construction and commissioning of refrigerated double wall storage tanks and mounded bullets for its LPG Terminal at Mundra,” according to a press release.

The statement also noted that the company has received the Letter of Award from the Mumbai Port Trust (MbPT) for Installation of off-shore/onshore pipeline and terminal work for the ‘Fifth Oil (J5) Berth’ at Jawahar Dweep in Mumbai Harbour for a contract value of ₹209 crore.

The tankage contract from Adani entails EPCC of two double-walled refrigerated tanks of 25,000 mt and two mounded bullets of 1018 M3 capacity each.
