## Punj Lloyd, Israel's IWI Set Up Small Arms Unit

Gwalior: Punj Lloyd and Israeli firearms maker Israel Wea-pon Industries (IWI) have launched India's first private small arms unit, which hopes toget orders of up to ₹5,000 cro-re in two to three years. "We have a very clear target;

we are focusing on aerostructure, small arms, and guns," Atul Punj, chairman of Punj Lloyd, told **ET** after the inaugu-ration of the plant in Malan-pur, Madhya Pradesh. He said the venture targets an order booking of between ₹3,000-5,000 crore in two-three years, "depending on our success in different programmes.

Samy Katsav, chairman of SK Group of which IWI is a mem-ber, said, "The joint venture is

The finished products will be for the use of the country's forces, Wadhawan said.
